January 6 **Monday** Orientation and testing begin for new undergraduate students.

January 7 **Tuesday** Registration for the spring semester for new and readmitted students who have not yet registered; to complete registration, fees must be paid no later than 5:00 PM on January 10.

January 8–9 **Wednesday–Thursday** Registration for the spring semester for continuing students who have not yet registered; to complete registration, fees must be paid no later than 5:00 PM on January 10.

January 9 **Thursday** University Health Services benefits become available to all students.

January 10 **Friday** Add/drop for the spring semester for students who registered and paid their fees by December 11.
Fee bills for students who registered after November 8 due no later than 5:00 PM.

January 13 **Monday** Classes begin.
International Education Fee (IEF) Scholarship competition for the summer session and the fall semester begins.

January 16 **Thursday** Last day of the official add/drop period; after this date, changes in registration require the approval of the chair and usually the student's dean. (See *General Information*, chapter 4, for required approvals.)
Last day undergraduate students may register without the approval of the registrar.
Last day graduate students may register and pay fees without the approval of the graduate dean.

January 20 **Monday** Martin Luther King Jr. Day holiday.

January 29 **Wednesday** Twelfth class day; this is the date the official enrollment count is taken.
Last day an undergraduate student may add a course except for rare and extenuating circumstances.
Payment for added courses (add bill) due.
Last day to drop a course for a possible refund. (See *General Information*, chapter 4, for required approvals.)
Last day a graduate student may, with the required approvals, add a course.

January 30 **Thursday** Last day to apply for a graduate degree.

February 10 **Monday** Last day to drop a course without a possible academic penalty. (See *General Information*, chapter 4, for required approvals.)

February 12 **Wednesday** Second tuition installment payment due for students who selected the three-payment plan.

February 15 **Saturday** Priority date for student financial aid applications for the summer session.

March 3 **Monday** Application deadline for Study Abroad Program for the summer session and the fall semester.

March 7 **Friday** Intrasemester reports due in the deans' offices.

March 10–15 **Monday–Saturday** Spring break.

March 17 **Monday** Application deadline for International Education Fee (IEF) Scholarship for study abroad programs for the summer session and the fall semester.

March 19 **Wednesday** Final tuition installment payment due for students who selected the three-payment plan.

March 24 **Monday** Last day an undergraduate student may, with the dean's approval, withdraw from the University or drop a course except for urgent and substantiated, nonacademic reasons.
Last day a student may change registration in a course to or from the pass/fail or credit/no credit basis.
Last day to apply for an undergraduate degree.
Last day an undergraduate student or a law student may register in absentia.

March 31 **Monday** Priority date for student financial aid applications for the fall semester.

April 9–11, 14–18 **Wednesday–Friday, Monday–Friday** Academic advising for continuing and readmitted students for the summer session and the fall semester.

April 14–18 **Monday–Friday** Registration for the summer session for continuing and readmitted students.

April 21–May 2 **Monday–Saturday, Monday–Friday (two weeks, excluding Sunday)** Registration for the fall semester for continuing and readmitted students.

April 22 **Tuesday** Registration fee bills for the summer session mailed to students.

April 28 **Monday** Last class day in the School of Law.

April 29 **Tuesday** Reading day in the School of Law.

April 30–May 3, 5–10, 12–13 **Wednesday–Saturday, Monday–Saturday, Monday–Tuesday** Spring semester final examinations in the School of Law.

May 1 **Thursday** Institute of International Education (IIE) Fulbright and other grants competition for the 2003–2004 academic year begins.

May 2 **Friday** Last class day except in the School of Law.
Last day to submit master's report, recital, thesis, doctoral dissertation, or treatise to the graduate dean.
Last day a graduate student may, with the approval of the instructor, the graduate adviser, and the graduate dean, drop a course.

May 5–6, 11 **Monday–Tuesday, Sunday** No-class days.

May 7–10, 12–13 **Wednesday–Saturday, Monday–Tuesday** Spring semester final examinations except in the School of Law.

May 13 **Tuesday** Payment deadline for students who registered for the summer session during the spring.
