

# ACADEMIC CALENDAR

## Summer Session 2009

<b>May 25</b>	<b>Monday</b> Memorial Day holiday.
<b>May 26–28</b>	<b>Tuesday–Thursday</b> Add/drop for the summer session for students who have registered and paid their tuition and fees.
<b>May 30</b>	<b>Saturday</b> Summer residence halls open at 9:00 AM.
<b>June 1</b>	<b>Monday</b> Orientation and testing begin for new undergraduate students.  University Health Services benefits become available to registered students.
<b>June 2–3</b>	<b>Tuesday–Wednesday</b> Registration for the summer session; students who register on June 2–3 will register for all classes to be taken during the summer session. To complete registration, undergraduate students must pay tuition and fees by 5:00 PM on June 3; graduate and law students must pay tuition and fees by 5:00 PM on June 5.
<b>June 4</b>	<b>Thursday</b> Classes begin for first-term, nine-week, and whole-session classes.
<b>June 5</b>	<b>Friday</b> Last day of the official add/drop period for first-term, nine-week, and whole-session classes; after this date, changes in registration require the approval of the department chair and usually the student's dean. (See <i>General Information</i> , chapter 4, for details.)  5:00 PM: Tuition and fee payment deadline for graduate and law students.
<b>June 9</b>	<b>Tuesday</b> Fourth class day for first-term, nine-week, and whole-session classes; this is the date the official enrollment count is taken.  Last day an undergraduate student may add a first-term, nine-week, or whole-session class except for rare and extenuating circumstances.  Payment for added classes (add bill) due by 5:00 PM.  Last day to drop a first-term, nine-week, or whole-session class for a possible refund. (See <i>General Information</i> , chapter 4, for details.)  Last day a graduate student or a law student may, with the required approvals, add a first-term, nine-week, or whole-session class.

<b>June 11</b>	<b>Thursday</b> Last day to apply for a graduate degree.  Registration for the fall semester begins for new summer session students who have paid their tuition and fees for summer, and for continuing and readmitted students who have not yet registered for fall.
<b>June 17</b>	<b>Wednesday</b> Last day to drop a first-term, nine-week, or whole-session class without a possible academic penalty. (See <i>General Information</i> , chapter 4, for details.)
<b>June 24</b>	<b>Wednesday</b> Last day a student may change registration in a first-term, nine-week, or whole-session class to or from the pass/fail or credit/no credit basis.
<b>June 30</b>	<b>Tuesday</b> Last class day for first-term two-hour law classes.  Last day to drop a first-term two-hour law class, with required approvals.
<b>July 1</b>	<b>Wednesday</b> Reading day for first-term two-hour law classes.
<b>July 2–3</b>	<b>Thursday–Friday</b> Final examinations for first-term two-hour law classes.
<b>July 9</b>	<b>Thursday</b> Last class day for first-term classes, including three-hour law classes.  Last day to drop a first-term class. (See <i>General Information</i> , chapter 4, for details.)
<b>July 10</b>	<b>Friday</b> Registration for students enrolling for second term only. To complete registration, undergraduate students must pay tuition and fees by 5:00 PM on July 10; graduate and law students must pay tuition and fees by 5:00 PM on July 14.
<b>July 10–11</b>	<b>Friday–Saturday</b> Final examinations for first-term classes, including three-hour law classes. Nine-week and whole-session classes do not meet.
<b>July 13</b>	<b>Monday</b> Classes begin for second-term classes.

<b>July 14</b>	<p><b>Tuesday</b> Last day of the official add/drop period for the second term; after this date, changes in registration require the approval of the department chair and usually the student's dean. (See <i>General Information</i>, chapter 4, for details.)</p> <p>5:00 PM: Tuition and fee payment deadline for graduate and law students.</p>	<b>July 29–30</b>	<p><b>Wednesday–Thursday</b> Final examinations for nine-week classes other than law classes.</p>
<b>July 16</b>	<p><b>Thursday</b> Fourth class day for second-term classes; this is the date the official enrollment count is taken.</p> <p>Last day an undergraduate student may add a second-term class except for rare and extenuating circumstances.</p> <p>Payment for added classes (add bill) due by 5:00 PM.</p> <p>Last day to drop a second-term class for a possible refund. (See <i>General Information</i>, chapter 4, for details.)</p> <p>Last day a graduate student or a law student may, with the required approvals, add a second-term class.</p>	<b>July 30–31</b>	<p><b>Thursday–Friday</b> Final examinations for nine-week law classes.</p>
<b>July 17</b>	<p><b>Friday</b> Last day to apply for an undergraduate or a law degree.</p> <p>Last day an undergraduate student or a law student may register in absentia.</p> <p>Last day during the summer session for new summer session students and continuing and readmitted students to register for the fall semester.</p>	<b>July 31</b>	<p><b>Friday</b> Last day a student may change registration in a second-term class to or from the pass/fail or credit/no credit basis.</p>
<b>July 21</b>	<p><b>Tuesday</b> Tuition and fee bills for the fall semester distributed to students electronically. Notice is sent to the e-mail address on the student's record.</p>	<b>August 7</b>	<p><b>Friday</b> Last class day for second-term two-hour law classes.</p> <p>Last day to drop a second-term two-hour law class, with required approvals.</p>
<b>July 24</b>	<p><b>Friday</b> Last day to drop a second-term class without a possible academic penalty. (See <i>General Information</i>, chapter 4, for details.)</p>	<b>August 10–11</b>	<p><b>Monday–Tuesday</b> Final examinations for second-term two-hour law classes.</p>
<b>July 28</b>	<p><b>Tuesday</b> Last class day for nine-week classes.</p> <p>Last day to drop a nine-week class. (See <i>General Information</i>, chapter 4, for details.)</p>	<b>August 12</b>	<p><b>Wednesday</b> 5:00 PM: Tuition and fee payment deadline for undergraduate students who registered for the fall semester by July 17. The payment deadline for graduate and law students is the fourth class day of the fall semester.</p>
<b>July 29</b>	<p><b>Wednesday</b> Reading day for nine-week law classes.</p>	<b>August 14</b>	<p><b>Friday</b> Last class day for second-term and whole-session classes, including three- and four-hour law classes.</p> <p>Last day to submit master's report, recital, thesis, doctoral dissertation, or treatise to the graduate dean.</p> <p>Last day to drop a second-term or whole-session class. (See <i>General Information</i>, chapter 4, for details.)</p>
		<b>August 15, 17</b>	<p><b>Saturday, Monday</b> Final examinations for second-term and whole-session classes, including three- and four-hour law classes.</p>
		<b>August 17</b>	<p><b>Monday</b> Official graduation date. (No public exercises.)</p>
		<b>August 18</b>	<p><b>Tuesday</b> Summer residence halls close at 9:00 AM.</p>
